M1. Sixth Grade: Tour de Tennessee

Instructors: Mrs. Couch, Mrs. Hawkins, Mrs. Standifer, and Coach Thompson

Course Study: Students will gain an understanding of the history and science that makes up our great state of Tennessee while touring the cities of Chattanooga and Nashville.

Fee: \$80 + meals

Wednesday, January 7: Nashville, TN
